Cambridge Realty Capital Companies has closed on an \$8.8 million FHA-insured HUD Lean loan to refinance San Dimas Retirement Center, a 258-bed assisted living and memory care facility in San Dimas, Calif.

Cambridge Chairman Jeffrey A. Davis said the fully-amortized, 22.5-year term loan was arranged for the owner, a California limited partnership, using the HUD Section 232 pursuant to Section 223(f) funding program.

Coordinating the transaction was National Originations Manager Hymie Barber, who also is Managing Director of Catalyst/Cambridge Health Care Finance in Los Angeles, the company's West Coast affiliate. Underwriting the loan was Cambridge Realty Capital Ltd. of Illinois, the Cambridge business that specializes in underwriting FHA-insured HUD loans. The interest rate was not announced.

Privately owned since its founding in 1983 as a real estate investment banker specializing in commercial real estate properties, Cambridge today has three distinctive business units: FHA-insured HUD loans, conventional financing, and investments and acquisitions.
